Please review the nomination package and contact our Admin Team with any questions. We are here to assist you in selling your quality horse at a good price. Our role is to market your horse through social media, our website, and our auction platform. To achieve this, we require your assistance by presenting a well-prepared, exceptionally turned-out horse on Presentation Days. Additionally, submitting complete information in the online nomination form, including show videos, professional show photos, well-written catalogue notes, and detailed vet information, are highly beneficial.

How to Proceed For Nominations

- **Nomination Opening June 29, 2026**
- **Nomination Deadline is July 27th, 2026 @ 6 PM MST.**
- Complete the nomination form online at www.canadianwarmbloodauktion.ca with payment completed online (if you require alternative payment arrangements, please contact the Sale Admin)
- Send the following Nomination Documents after submission to admin@cwauktion.ca:

- o Scan of the horse's registration certificate or proof of pending registration
 - o Proof of Performance Record (if applicable)
 - o A conformation photo of the horse standing in the open stance, taken from the side
- You will be notified by email of your horses' acceptance no later than August 7st, 2026.

How to Proceed After Acceptance

- **Acceptance Notification is August 7st, 2026 @ ~ 6 PM MST**
- After receiving notification of acceptance by email, you will be required to do the following:
 - o Pay the balance of the Nomination Fee if still outstanding (see payment schedule)
 - o Submit 'Catalogue Notes' no later than August 7th – August 21st 2026 for the nominated horse(s), as well as their sire and dam
 - In your 'Catalogue Notes' for young horses please include comments regarding siblings from the mother-line who are doing well in sport, as well as any accolades that your young horse has achieved themselves. Inclusion inspection results are helpful. MAXIMUM 500 WORDS. Please ensure any horses referenced are done so in all CAPITAL LETTERS.

Presentation Days

- **All accepted horses are required to attend one of the Presentation Days on August 22nd – August 25th at Old Gate Farm in Olds, Alberta. No exceptions.**
- All horses must have a Current Negative ELISA/Coggins drawn between June 15, 2026 and Aug 14, 2026 - no later than August 14th, 2026 to attend Presentation Days (this test is valid for all sale requirements)
- Our Sale Office will contact you to book your Presentation Day spot. Limited overnight stabling is available during the presentation days. Please let our office know if you require overnight stabling
- At Presentation Days your horse will be professionally filmed and photographed in free movement as well as free jumping and riding under saddle (where applicable) and at the discretion of the Sale Admin Team
- Professional conformation, head shots, leg shots and a walk video will be completed too. Marketing material will be available to each consignor for their own advertising use.
- Each consignor **must be a current member** in good standing with CWHBA to attend Presentation Days. Please contact office@canadianwarmbloods.com for membership inquiries
- All individuals (i.e. handlers) attending the Presentation Day **MUST** bring either their CWHBA Membership Number or their personal AEF Membership for insurance purposes and complete a waiver. *No exceptions will be granted.*
- **IMPORTANT** - Physical copies of registration papers OR proof of pending registration **MUST** be turned in on Presentation Days with owner completed transfer forms for the appropriate registry and payment for transfer.

After the Sale

- Sold horses will be insured with BFL Insurance for 10 days following the close of the sale and ending on October 29th, 2026
- The seller is obligated to provide board at no extra charge for up to 10 days following the close of the sale (ending October 29th, 2026)

Terms, Conditions, Limiting Criteria & Governing Policy

Basic Eligibility

Horses eligible for nomination must be registered Canadian Warmblood (CWHBA) or with another recognized Warmblood registry below:

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Limiting Criteria

- Priority will be given to CWHBA registered horses at the discretion of the Sale Committee
- Special consideration **MAY** be given to horses with an exceptional show record or with siblings from the direct mother-line with exceptional show records
- Approximately 55 lots will be accepted for the 2026 Canadian Warmblood Fall Classic Breeders' Sale
- Other *Limiting Criteria* may include performance and/or pedigree – including but not limited to dam approval scores (based on inspections) and stallion approval/licensing status. The nominated horses' linear profile may be considered as well.
- *All selections made are at the sole discretion of the Sale Committee.*

- In your nomination, please include as much information as possible about your horse's performance record, schooling shows, ability (free jump video for a jumper prospect or free movement for dressage prospects where it would be an asset), other noteworthy siblings out of the dam-line and any other pertinent information for the Sale Committee to make their decision
- The classification for the category is as follows with age as of January 1st of the year of nomination:

Broodmare <i>Must be 15 years of age and under</i>	Broodmares must be at least 90 days pregnant at time of sale and have pregnancy confirmed at time of PPE. Must be bred before July 19 th , 2026. Mare meets breed eligibility requirements (including inspection) and has been bred by a stallion entered in the CWHBA Studbook. They must perform the same basic PPE as weanlings and yearlings. Can accept recipient mares carrying a foal that meets sale criteria.
Weanling	It is <u>strongly</u> recommended that weanlings are shown at their dam's side for Presentation Days. Must perform the PPE as required by the sale committee, which includes trotting for soundness.
Yearling	Must perform the PPE as required by the sale committee, which includes trotting for soundness. Basic x-ray requirement is recommended but not mandatory.
Two-Year-Old Prospect	Must perform the PPE as required by the sale committee, which includes trotting for soundness and basic x-ray requirement.
Prospects <i>3 to 6 years of age</i>	Must be 3 to 6 years of age. 3 years old – started under saddle <u>or</u> ready to start under saddle. 4 years or older – must be started under saddle.
Performance Horses <i>Must be 5 to 12 years of age</i>	Performance horses must have shown at a minimum of two EC or USEF rated shows or have proof of attending five schooling shows in the past 18 months. Performance Record must be submitted at time of Nomination.

Nomination Information

- All owner(s) agree that by nominating their horse(s) they will provide the sale with all required veterinarian documentation including x-rays, negative EIA, insurance forms, vaccination records, medication form and videoed flexion tests (required for horses three and older). These will be sent to the Admin Team ON TIME. Failure to do so will forfeit all fees and your horse will not be sold through the sale. See page 6 for dates.
- All owner(s) agree that by nominating their horse(s) they will allow them to be tested for any banned substances according to the Equine Canada Medication Control Committee. Every horse must have blood drawn at their PPE and it must be held by the sellers' vet for 45 days after the sale.
- Where the owner of a horse is a partnership, limited company, ranch or farm, all legal signatories must sign the Seller Declaration form and agree on the sale Terms and Conditions.
- All truthful information and representations of the horses consigned are the sole responsibility of the seller or agent of the seller, as per the sale *Terms and Conditions*.
- The seller acknowledges they have read and agree to the full sale Terms and Conditions upon submitting their Nomination.

- All original papers for CWHBA registered (or pending) horses must be turned in to our office no later than presentation days, along with the corresponding signed transfer of ownership forms. European Passports/Papers and Passports/Papers from any other registry should be transferred directly to the buyer from the seller and will not be handled by the sale admin.
- All original papers for CWHBA registered horses, once received by sale admin, will be sent directly to the National office to await sale completion. The papers will then be transferred accordingly.
- Sellers will be required to provide a bill of sale, directly made out to the successful bidder. The sale admin will ensure the consigner has the correct information.
- Proof of transfer will be required for sale disbursement to take place. In the case of a pending registration, the registration form must be completed, DNA included with the DNA form and proof of submission to the respective registry sent into our office no later than October 30th, 2026.

Withdrawals & Refunds

- Applies to all horses that are consigned, no exceptions
- Withdrawal before August 15th, 2026, all fees refunded less the Admin Fee (\$200.00)
- Withdrawal between August 15th, 2026 – September 15th, 2026, all Nomination Fees (less the Admin Fee) refunded at 50%
- Withdrawal after September 15th, 2026, no refunds will be issued

Commissions

A flat rate commission will be charged on each horse sold at a rate of 10%:

No selling commission will be charged for horses who are not sold. The last bidder **must** be the listed owner OR pre-disclosed agent for this to be valid. The Sale Admin must be notified **immediately** after the close of the sale if the bidder represented the owner.

Minimum Bids

- Minimum starting bid will be set at \$7 500 CAD for weanling, yearlings, 2-year-olds and broodmares
- Minimum starting bid will be set at \$10 000 CAD for prospects and performance horses

Final Disbursements

1. The CWHBA Alberta Chapter acts only as a clearing house for funds collected for and on behalf of the seller
2. GST is collected for and on behalf of the seller ONLY when the seller provides a valid GST registration # prior to the close of the sale and in accordance with Canadian law
3. Consignor's accounts will be settled when the bank hold has been released from the purchaser's funds – please note payment method by seller will determine length of hold time
4. Payments will be sent via Cheque or E-transfer to seller – any outstanding amounts owing will be deducted from your payment at this time
5. Each consignor will be issued a single payment to settle the account. For multiple consignments, settlement will occur when final purchaser funds are released

August 7 th	Acceptance notifications will be emailed with results (selected, wait-listed, not selected) from the Sales Admin as well as next steps
August 14 th	- Balance of Nomination fees due in full - ELISA / Coggins cut off for Presentation Days & Sale Requirements - Negative results must be submitted 24 hours prior to arrival
August 7 th - 21 st	- Catalogue notes due - Final catalogue notes on all consigned horses submitted to Sale Admin (August 21st cutoff)
August 22 nd – 25 th	Presentation Days @ Old Gate Farm (Olds, AB) - Consigners must have valid CWHBA Membership, handlers must have CWHBA Membership and/or AEF Membership
September 1 st	Additional Performance Horse photos and video due
September 16 th – September 25 th	- Complete PPE exam form (vet and seller portion on website) with flexion test videos and blood drawn for storage (due September 25th) - Radiographs within six months of October 30th, 2026 are acceptable NOTE: The PPE cannot be performed before September 16th, 2026, due to insurance purposes
September 21 st	- Sale catalogue released - Auction website goes live with lots listed - Tryouts can be booked from now until October 16th, 2026 at seller's own discretion with any potential bidders
September 25 th	PPE & Flexions submission deadline
October 5 th	Pre-sale Consignor Meeting via Zoom @ 7:00 PM MST
October 16 ^h	Auction bidding goes live online!
October 19 th	Auction ends!
October 29 th	All sold horses are insured and seller provides board to buyer at no charge during this 10-day window
